**The Asian Dragons Open Chess Tournament 2011 to be held in
Taipei, Taiwan, from August 6-13, 2011.**

INTRODUCTION

The Asian Dragons Invitational Tournament was firstly held in Kaohsiung in 2007, being the first international chess tournament organized by Chinese Taipei Chess Association. The purpose of the tournament was to provide the opportunity for developing players with ratings below 2200 to compete against players with similar strength offering them a friendly yet competitive environment. With this purpose in mind, the tournament was played in round-robin format for the Open section and Under 16 section with players coming from the following countries: Macau, Hong Kong, Japan, Singapore, Korea and the host Fed. Chinese Taipei. After many years of success, the host federation had received many requests to participate from countries other than mentioned above. Therefore, the organizers have switched the format to Swiss this year in order to encourage more chess players to participate in this event and to spread and strengthen the chess culture. In keeping with its original Asian Dragons spirit, we continue to invite players from Hong Kong, Macau, Japan, Singapore and Korea but at the same time we now openly welcome players from all over the world.

REGULATIONS

1. TOURNAMENT

Swiss 9 rounds,

2. TOURNAMENT RULES

2.1 System of Play

The tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess. The tournament will be conducted as Swiss system of 9 rounds and will be played according to FIDE regulations.

2.2 Time control

The time control is 90 minutes for each player for the entire game with 30 seconds increment per move from move one.

2.3 Tie-break

FIDE Tie-Break Regulations shall be applied.

3. ELIGIBILITY & PARTICIPATION

3.1 Eligible to participate are all players with FIDE rating 1600~2200 for Open Section. FIDE rating under 2200 for Youth Under 16 Section.

3.2 The host federation has the right to accept unrated local players to a maximum of one fifth of the total players per section.

3.3 To maintain Asian Dragon original spirit, those invited federations have the rights to send players not subject to the regulation 3.1

3.4 In order to provide appropriate tournament conditions, the Federations must complete carefully the official registration form (attached to this file) and send it back to the organizing committee no later than **June 15**.

5. VENUE

The tournament will be held at the National Taiwan University which is located at the center of Taipei city. Players should take plane to Taoyuan International airport, Taiwan.

6. Registration

6.1 Participants must pay registration fee of 100EUR which includes luncheon, dinner, one banquet and hotel – airport transportation.

6.2 Two (2) players per section and one (1) official per federation for invited federations are free.

7. ACCOMMODATION

7.1 Free board and lodging for 2 players per section and 1 official (coach) per federation for invited federations from noon of 6th to noon of 14th in Taipei Hero House hotel on a triple room basis.

7.2 Single occupancy or spouse occupancy will not be covered by the host federation. For such cases, players (accompanying person) have to pay 30 EUR per day per person for shared triple room or 40 EUR for shared double room in the Hero House hotel.

7.3 Official Hotel : Hotel Taipei Hero House

a. in triple rooms : 30 EUR per person per day (B+B) ,7 nights = 210 Euro

b. in double rooms: 40 EUR per person per day (B+B) ,7 nights = 280 Euro

c. in single rooms : 60 EUR per person per day (B+B) , 7 nights = 420 Euro

a. in double rooms: 65 EUR per person per day (B+B) , 7 nights = 455 Euro

b. in single rooms: 120 EUR per person per day (B+B) , 7 nights = 840 Euro

8. CHIEF ARBITER AND HIS ASSISTANTS

The host federation will appoint the Chief Arbiter, his Deputy and Assistants.

9. APPEALS COMMITTEE

The host federation after consultation with the participating federations shall appoint the Appeals Committee comprising three persons from different federations. A protest fee of USD 100 shall be paid in advance but this amount is refundable if the protest is upheld.
